Is my dog ready for Family Dog 2?

For truest results test your dog in 3 places:

- 1) at home
- 2) out in a mildly distracting situation
- 3) in a dog training class

My dog understands the word "Yes!" as a marker sound for good behavior.
My dog will touch my hand with his or her nose on cue In a mildly distracting situation.
My dog will turn and pay attention to me when I call his or her name the first time.
My dog can give me eye contact when I am still.
My dog understands a release cue such as "break", "free", "OK" or "all done".
My dog will sit on my first request and will wait for a release cue before moving.
My dog will lie down on my first request and will wait for a release cue before moving.
My dog can hold a 15 second sit stay with reinforcement and few distractions.
My dog can walk next to me on a leash without pulling for 30 feet, turn and come back.
My dog will leave food alone when held in a open hand in front of him or her.
My dog can come 4 out of 5 times from 20 feet on a long line, using toys or treats reward.
My dog is quiet in class, barking only on rare occasions, if at all.
If you can say yes to 8 of these statements, then proceed to Family Dog 2.
If you answer no to 6 or more of these statements, proceed to Family Dog 1.
