## Is my dog ready for Family Dog 3?

Ideally you would test your dog in 3 places:

- 1) at home
- 2) out in a mildly distracting situation
- 3) in a dog training class

	My dog will turn and pay attention to me when I call his or her name the first time with dogs and people walking nearby.
	My dog can give me eye contact when I am moving.
	My dog can hold a 1 minute sit stay with reinforcement and people and dogs are walking by 30 feet away or toys are placed on the ground around him.
	My dog will sit to greet familiar and new dogs and people with treats, a toy or rewards .
	My dog will sit for passers-by who are passing 6 feet away.
	My dog can walk next to me on a leash without pulling for 60 feet, turn and come back. 60 feet.
	My dog will sit at doors as I go through first and come to my side when I give him the release word.
	My dog will leave food alone when placed on the floor in front of him or her.
	My dog can come 4 out of 5 times from 30 feet, while other dogs are walking or running nearby if I have him on a long line and/or have treats, a toy or other appropriate reward.
	My dog is quiet in class, barking only on rare occasions, if at all.
	My dog is comfortable with new dogs and people.
-	ou can say yes to 8 or more of these statements, then proceed to Family Dog 3 otherwise oceed to Family Dog 2.
