## Positive Training Fetches Positive Results!

## Is my dog ready for Family Dog 4?

Ideally you would test your dog in 3 places:

- 1) at home
- 2) out in a mildly distracting situation
- 3) in a dog training class

	My dog will turn and pay attention to me when I call his or her name the first time with other dogs and people walking or running nearby. (ok to use rewards)
	My dog can give me eye contact for at least 10 seconds and will check in when I am moving.
	My dog can hold a 1 minute sit stay and a 2 minute down stay people and dogs are walking by 15 feet away or toys or food are placed on the ground around him (use of rewards is okay)
	My dog will do a down and a sit for me when I am 6 feet away.
	My dog will sit for passers-by who are passing 4 feet away.
	My dog can walk next to me on a leash without pulling when there are other dogs and people walking nearby.
	My dog will leave food alone when walking by a bowl of food or food on the ground. I do not have to pull my dog away from the object with his leash, and I do not have to step into my dog with a body block.
	My dog can come 4 out of 5 times from 40 feet, while other dogs are walking or running nearby if I have him on a long line and/or have treats, a toy or other appropriate reward.
	My dog is quiet in class, barking only on rare occasions, if at all.
	My dog is comfortable with new dogs and people.
	ou can say yes to 7 or more of these statements, then proceed to Family Dog 4 otherwise oceed to Family Dog 3.
